

Activities

- Expand public access to federal survey data
- Acquire and integrate administrative and other non-traditional data sources
- ✓ Provide data-linkage capabilities
- Ensure privacy protection protocols are followed
- Foster working relationships among all levels of government and non-government
- Analyze data and produce new and improved data products
- Expand information dissemination through new media

Who is NCSES - We are NSF's Federal Statistical Agency



- Mission: policy-neutral policy-relevant statistical data on the U.S. science and engineering enterprise often in a global context
- Federal clearinghouse for data that provides key insights on the American economy, responsibility for data on:
 - Research and development
 - Science and engineering workforce
 - US competitiveness in science, engineering, technology, and R&D
 - Condition and progress of STEM education


























NCSES's Policy Relevant, Policy Neutral Congressionally Mandated Reports Use A Variety of Data Sources





Access Report

In this 2018 study, the National Academies of Science recommended NCSES "should consider establishing research centers of excellence." (Recommendation 6-2, p. 133)

"One or more centers of excellence focused on science and engineering statistics could fulfill a variety of functions."

- Linking data and investigating options for expanding opportunities in this area
- Conducting analysis
- Conducting methodical research
- Supporting the development of the next generation of researchers


ADC Vision

The U.S. Data Ecosystem









Government PMO


Lead agency, Agreements Officer (AO) and AO Representative

AMERICA'S DATAHUB CONSORTIUM

Industry leaders, nontraditionals, and academic organizations conduct the research projects.



Governance body that provides guidance and oversight of ADC operations (to be formed)





Consortium Management Firm, facilitates ADC collaborative activities, contractual and financial administration of research projects.
