For each project, the objective is to link records using the sources noted in the RFS and to create a linked dataset that can be used for analysis as described in the RFS. This work will fill information gaps, including but not limited to building an infrastructure to inform linkages across the federal government, using the development of agreements, utilization secure server environment, and deployment of PPRL as a model to improve the availability, quality, accessibility, and interoperability of data sharing and linking.
