2	Do the proposers select the 5 agencies?	We would work in tandem with the offeror to select the 5 federal statistical agencies.
3	Is it the hope or expectation of the government that this "machine readability improvement" tool will be fully automated?	Our hope is that offerors can provide a solution that is fully automated. As proposals come in as solutions, we want to understand what offerors can provide in terms of automation.
4	Do you feel providing a FedRamp solution would be beneficial for this initiative?	Yes, if the solution being proposed by an offeror leverages the cloud.
5	Will any of the data products contain identifiable data? Or will it all be de-identified/aggregate data?	We will not be providing any identifiable data or personal data.
